Eurardy Reserve Field Trip

Join Bush Heritage Australia on a tag-along tour to Eurardy Reserve, home to more than 500 plant taxa and renowned for its spectacular wildflower displays.

Perfect for those with a 4WD, this field trip offers a sneak peak into a critical habitat link between Kalbarri National Park and Toolonga Nature Reserve.

Included in the trip:

- Visit a decade old 30,050 hectare conservation reserve
- Rare chance to see up to 49 threatened or priority-listed plant species
- Spot one of four listed bird species including the elusive Malleefowl
- Learn about work with volunteers, local community and researchers to protect areas of high ecological importance
